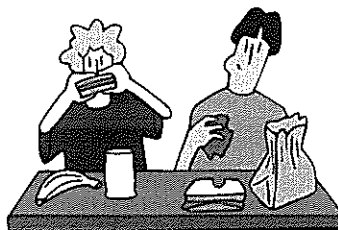
The Third Thursday of Every Month

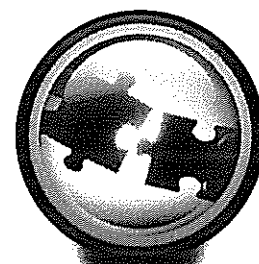
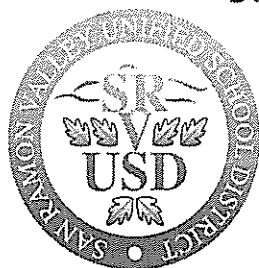
Accommodations in the General Education Classroom
