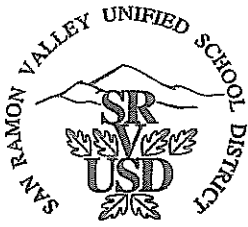

MINIMUM Insurance Limits of \$100,000/\$300,000 Bodily Injury and \$25,000 Property
